I need help for my child.
Has your child harmed or threatened to harm themselves or others? Is your child out of control? Are you unable to safely care for your child?

I answered **YES** to at least one of the questions above and/or my child appears to be experiencing a mental health crisis.

I answered **NO** to all of the questions above. I am concerned about my child's mental health, but it is not an emergency.
